We hope that all families continue to remain safe and well. Renu Hope Foundation continues to work closely with local school districts, collaboration partners and the local health departments to obtain the most up to date information regarding COVID-19.

On July 1, 2020, Governor Newsom released an update that Riverside County along with several other counties, are on a State watch list, *as confirmed positive cases continue to rise*. Governor Newsom has shared that *several indoor operations must close, effective immediately for a period of three weeks*. In addition, local public Health and County Board of Supervisors may impose additional mandates. You may also view Governor Newsom's broadcast at www.covid19.ca.gov, regarding this order.

It is our utmost priority to ensure the health, safety and welfare of our children, families and staff. At this time, Renu Hope Foundation has made the difficult decision to continue to remain closed for center-based services through July 31, 2020.

Although our center-based services will be closed during this time, the Renu Hope Team will continue to provide your family with distance learning through Learning Genie and weekly "grab and go meal distributions". Our Family Engagement Team will continue to work with you in supporting individual learning plans that are part of your family's daily routine. In addition, there will be an additional educational material bags distributed during the grab and go meals distribution the second week of July.

Additional updates will be provided to you on our website, as we assess and evaluate the current conditions of our communities. We will continue to work through this together. Please continue to stay safe and healthy.
